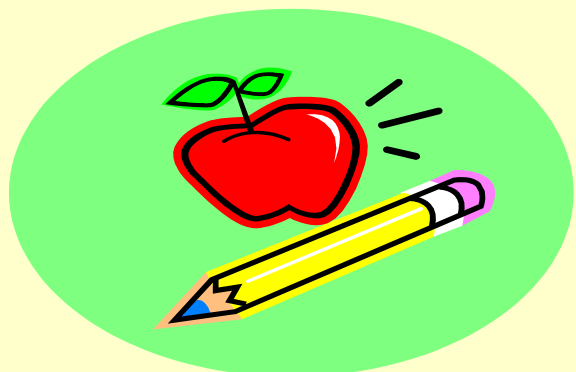
Welcome Aboard!
